22nd Letter of Ancient Hebrew Alphabet

Tav speaks of our universe and is marked by cycles in all things. The end of the human cycle is joyful. Complete redemption in Christ Jesus is the great Sabbath.

In order for creation to occur, God's nature fell into all of creation. All of the world of matter (visible) and (invisible) contains the power of God. God's divine nature is revealed in all of His creation so we are to seek all hindrances in creation that don't allow light to complete its cycle back to God - to return light unbroken to its source.

Tav also speaks of fervent prayer. To pray the Word with great passion, ask (demand), seek (dig as for buried treasure), knock (knock the door down). Prayer must come from the heart. Go to your closet and pray. As a Jesus idiom, it means pray what you believe fervently from your heart.

Tav refers to repentance – accurately, best translated means able, returning to the source. When we constantly seek to nurture and express our highest degree of excellence in every-day life, we are constantly allowing light to flow to us, through us, and back to its Source (God). Unforgiveness, judgment, offense are hindrances that stop light, love, life from returning to the Source. Self is the culprit.
