NUN

14th Letter of Hebrew Alphabet

“Covenant”

NUN represents #50 - faith and vibrancy of spiritual life.

Acts 2:1-4 - 50 days of Pentecost - power of the Holy Spirit

NUN is an Aramaic word for fish, meaning a great abundance, and fruitfulness. Jesus said, “Cast your nets on the other side.” And they caught so much fish that their nets began to break and nearly sunk their boats.

Joshua 1:1 - Joshua, a type of Christ who takes us into the Promise Land, was the son of (Nun) power of faith and vibrancy of spiritual life (the Word).

NUN relates to music tone and tune or vibration.

Good Vibrations

Stanford University studies have shown that *Ode to Joy* played during students' study time increased learning 25%. Music with words limits (though good) music with a text conclusion. But music with no words in specific tone and tune elevates us to spiritual inspiration.

Music opens the gate of the invisible and if used with meditation will elevate you in spiritual awareness and strengthen faith and bring spiritual inspiration.

(II Chronicles 20:21-22 - They went out singing, “Praise the Lord! His mercy endureth forever!” And the enemy was defeated and God's people prospered. Read it!)
